The cost of Medicare changes on a yearly basis. This resource is designed to provide you with a quick guide to navigate the costs associated with Medicare Parts A, B, and D for 2019.

■ Medicare Part A (Hospital Insurance)

- Monthly Premium: \$0 (for most people)
- Deductible: \$1,364

■ Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance)

- Monthly Premium: \$135.50, for most people (based on income)
- Deductible: \$185
