

## Insurance Covered Breast Pumps

### Required Steps

- Members must obtain a written prescription from their healthcare provider in order to have a breast pump filled.
- Members can give the prescription to our most commonly used Durable Medical Equipment (DME) providers as listed below.
- The DME provider will then coordinate to have the breast pumps mailed to the member.

*Please note:* Per ACA, the breast pump is covered at 100%.
